Based on the recent November 3, 2020 elections in the County, there is only one change to the composition of the LAFCO Commission membership: Michael McGlynn, Council Member from the City of Gustine was not reelected to the City Council. Therefore, there is a current vacancy of the Alternate Public Member position on the Commission, which will be filled by the City Selection Committee early next year in accordance with section 56325(b) of the Government Code. The City Selection Committee is comprised of the Mayors of the six cities within the County. No action is required by the Commission.
